THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Mike Hamilton

1 NOTROUBLE DECHAFRA is a high risk proposition given his recent breaks and just two wins from 30 starts. On the other hand, he was good enough to finish in the top three in each of the three most recent races in which he stayed trotting. Last time out it was a reasonably impressive performance in which he left from this same post position, pulled first-over from fourth at the half and easily took down The Power of Many who was 6-5. I wouldn't touch him if he was moving up in class but since he's right back at the same level, leaves from the same post, and faces many of the same horses, he has to be taken seriously.

9 THE POWER OF MANY worked hard to get and hold the lead in his most recent but when push came to shove Notrouble Dechafra proved to be the best. The Moreau barn has been on a roll for some time (7-for-15 or 46.7% in the period 08/31 to 09/05) so there's a chance that this 9-time winner will regain his winning form. Hopefully Post 9 will inflate the price.

3 SWAN FOR DEE is the one that got closest to Notrouble Dechafra in the aforementioned 08/28 edition of this \$12K-\$15K claiming handicap. And like Notrouble Dechafra, she has drawn the same post for the rematch. Now if she could just work out a little easier trip!

8 TAURUS DU PARC was particularly good when treated to a pocket trip behind the totally spent Dads Hat on 08/21. His odds continued their southward trend when he drew another inside post on 08/28 but in that race he wanted no part of Notrouble Dechafra despite having the inside lane open up for him in the final eighth. Things are about to get a little more complicated now that he leaves from Post 8.
